- Established in 1876 with a classroom of 52 students, SMMUSD has grown to serve 11,000 students, enriching its pupils with its robust Regional Occupation Program and Career Technical Education.
- Students are taught how to learn, discovering and developing an appetite for knowledge.
- This approach has not only resulted in a combined graduation rate of about 95% for the district's high school students, but has also led to Santa Monica and Malibu High Schools being rated at the top in the State and Nation.

EXTRAORDINARY ACHIEVEMENT FOR ALL STUDENTS

Headquartered in the diverse seaside communities of Santa Monica and Malibu, the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District is home to several elementary, middle, and high schools. The district also operates eleven early childhood education centers and an adult school, which provide vulnerable students the opportunity to receive adequate learning and stimulation.

A core vision of SMMUSD focuses on closing the achievement gap between students, through modernization and the provision of technology that transforms the education landscape. Acknowledging there is a growing demand for science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), SMMUSD wanted to take steps to ensure its schools had the tools required today to prepare both current and future students to be college and career ready.



BUILDING A FOUNDATION FOR THE FUTURE

To bring these necessary technologies to both teachers and students, SMMUSD's IT department has been transforming the district's infrastructure. In the past, non-centralized systems spread across 17 sites, resulting in a litany of challenges for its limited staff.

Rapid technology advancements and the corresponding expectations of students, parents, and teachers created several challenges for the district's IT department:

1. Updating current district-wide wired and wireless footprints was a great start but didn't cover the entire scope of what they wanted to achieve.
2. SMMUSD was having trouble meeting some or all of the requirements to implement new software or programs when suggested by school officials.
3. IT staff wanted their infrastructure to be as efficient as possible, with the ability to maintain their systems utilizing a small team without sacrificing their computing or storage resources.

SMMUSD wanted to further their use of technology within their schools and classrooms while making it simpler for their IT staff to manage the systems within their architecture. They turned to Meridian IT for help.

- **vCenter Server:** SMMUSD now also has a second instance of a vCenter server, creating another centralized platform to manage their vSphere environments. This allows them to automate their virtual infrastructure to deliver insights and results with confidence.
- **Site Recovery Manager Disaster Recovery:** To ensure their data and information stay safe, Anthony suggested the addition of VMware Site Recovery Manager, which covers up to 75 virtual machines for mission critical services. This allows for VMs to be readily available in the event of a failover scenario.
- **VMware Horizon View:** Serving kiosks, labs, and remote staff workers, Meridian IT helped to implement Horizon View for 350 users. SMMUSD can now deliver a consistent user experience utilizing different devices and locations, with optimization for their data center.
